

## JOB DESCRIPTION Head of English

The Head of English will be part of the senior school and responsible to the Headmaster. The successful candidate will teach English classes to Years 6-8 and lead the English curriculum across the school.

The following gives a broad outline of the main requirements of the post:

- Articulating a vision for excellence in students learning in English.
- Monitoring and improving standards in English throughout the school.
- Being a class teacher responsible for all areas of the English curriculum.
- Planning, preparing and presenting lessons that cater for the needs of the whole ability range within their class in accordance with school policy.
- Liaising with our Head of Learning Development.
- Being a Form Teacher when required.
- Being responsible for the pastoral care of the boys in your Form.
- Preparing, assessing and displaying work to facilitate positive pupil development.
- Meeting requirements for the assessment and recording of pupils' development.
- Encouraging good practice with regard to punctuality, behaviour, standards of work and homework.
- Working with scholars to help them prepare for scholarship exams.
- Providing feedback to parents on pupils' progress at parents' evenings and other (often less formal) meetings.
- Staying up to date with changes and developments in the structure of the curriculum as directed by the school.
- Carrying out duties assigned and covering lessons as necessary.
- Liaising with colleagues and working flexibly.
- Leading assemblies when needed and helping with the Year 6 play / production.
- Organising and accompanying a residential trip if required, as well as non-residential trips.
- Ensuring the effective and efficient deployment of classroom support.

## Also:

- To attend INSET, twilight and staff meetings as required / appropriate.
- Attend Speech Day, church services and other events which may occur outside normal working hours.
- Undertake any other tasks or duties that the Headmaster may reasonably assign.

## Person Specification:

• A caring, enthusiastic, team player with good communication skills.

- Ability to support up to 13+ scholarship level.
- Experience in a similar setting would be an advantage, in addition to appropriate qualifications.
