

JOB DESCRIPTION Key Stage 1 / Reception Class Teacher

The Key Stage 1 / Reception class Teacher will be part of our Pre-Prep team. The role reports to the Head of Pre-Prep and the Headmaster.

The following gives a broad outline of the main requirements of the post:

- Being a class teacher responsible for all areas of the primary curriculum.
- Being responsible for the pastoral care of the boys.
- Planning, preparing and presenting lessons and homework that cater for the needs of the whole ability range within the class in accordance with school policy.
- Ensuring the effective and efficient deployment of classroom support.
- Challenging the more able pupils.
- Liaising with our Head of Learning Development.
- Preparing, marking and displaying work to facilitate positive pupil development.
- Meeting requirements for the assessment and recording of pupils' development.
- Organising regular class reading.
- Encouraging good practice with regard to punctuality, behaviour, standards of work and homework.
- Providing feedback to parents on a pupil's progress at parents' evenings and other (often less formal) meetings.
- Staying up to date with changes and developments in the structure of the curriculum as directed by the school / external organisations.
- Carrying out duties assigned and covering lessons as necessary.
- Taking part in school events and activities that may be run at weekends or evenings, such as Speech Day, Carol and Easter services.
- Liaising with colleagues and working flexibly.
- Leading assemblies when needed and organising the Year 1 play.
- Participating in the Pre-Prep open afternoons for parents, held each term.
- Organising and accompanying school trips.

Also:

- To attend INSET, twilight and staff meetings as required / appropriate.
- To run a club(s) to support the extra-curricular provision of the school.
- Undertake any other tasks or duties that the Headmaster may reasonably assign.

Person Specification:

- A caring, enthusiastic, team player with good communication skills.
- Experience in a similar setting would be an advantage but not essential, in addition to appropriate qualifications.
